Internet Explorer

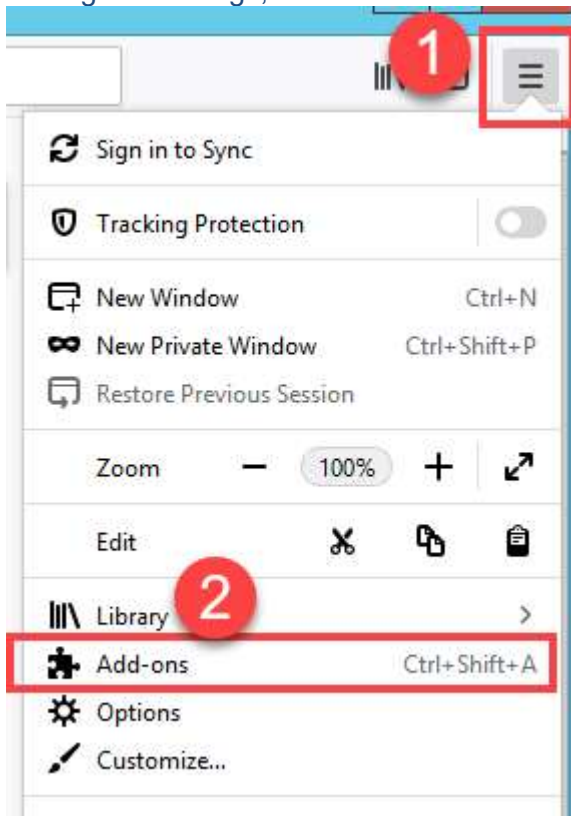
You should see the RoboForm tool bar, and will just have to login to RoboForm (if you haven't done it with one of the other browsers).

Firefox

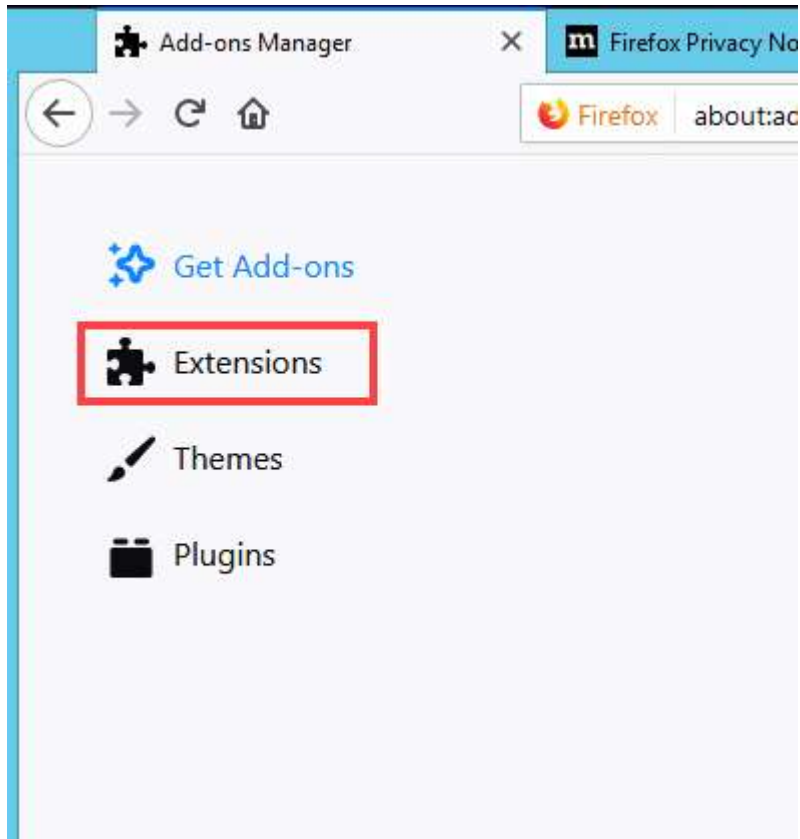
If Roboform icon does not show in the Firefox tool bar



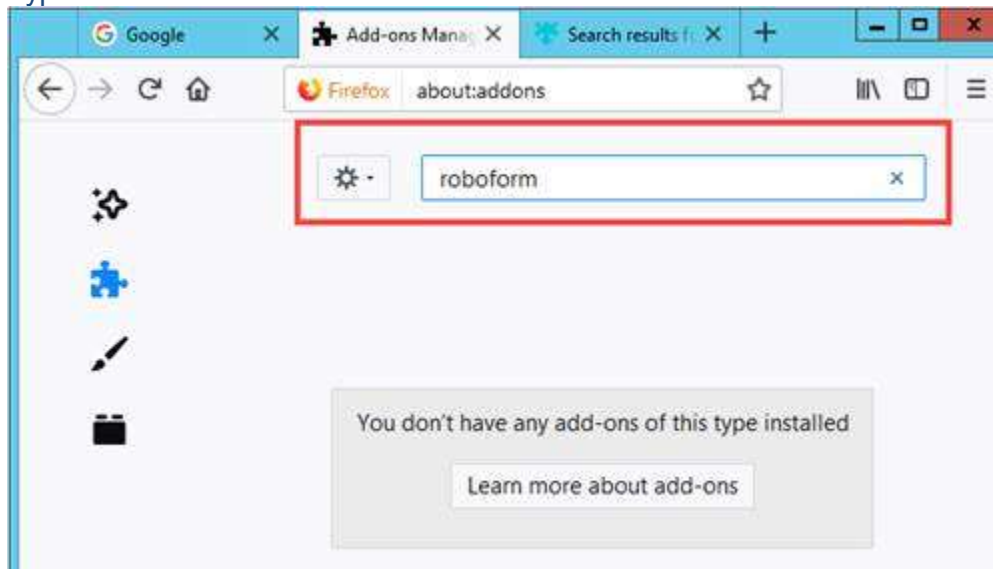
Then go to Settings, then Add-ons



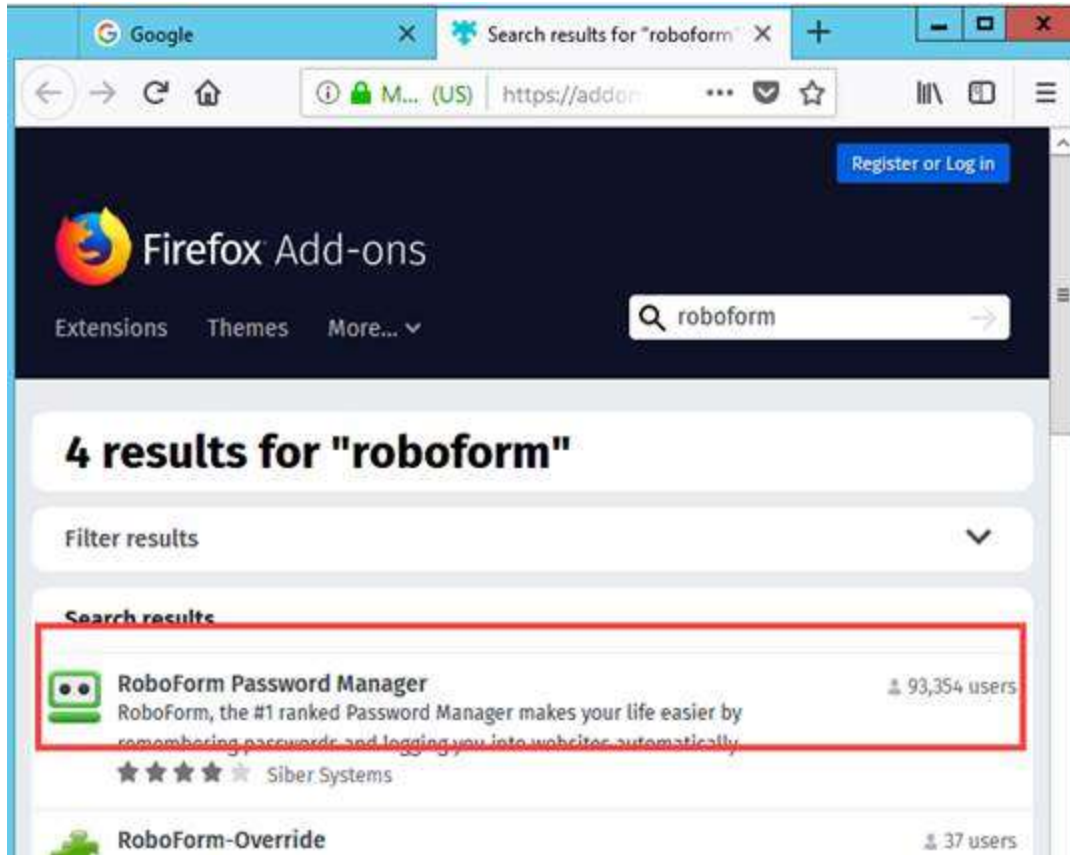
Next, click on Extensions



Type Roboform in the search bar and hit enter



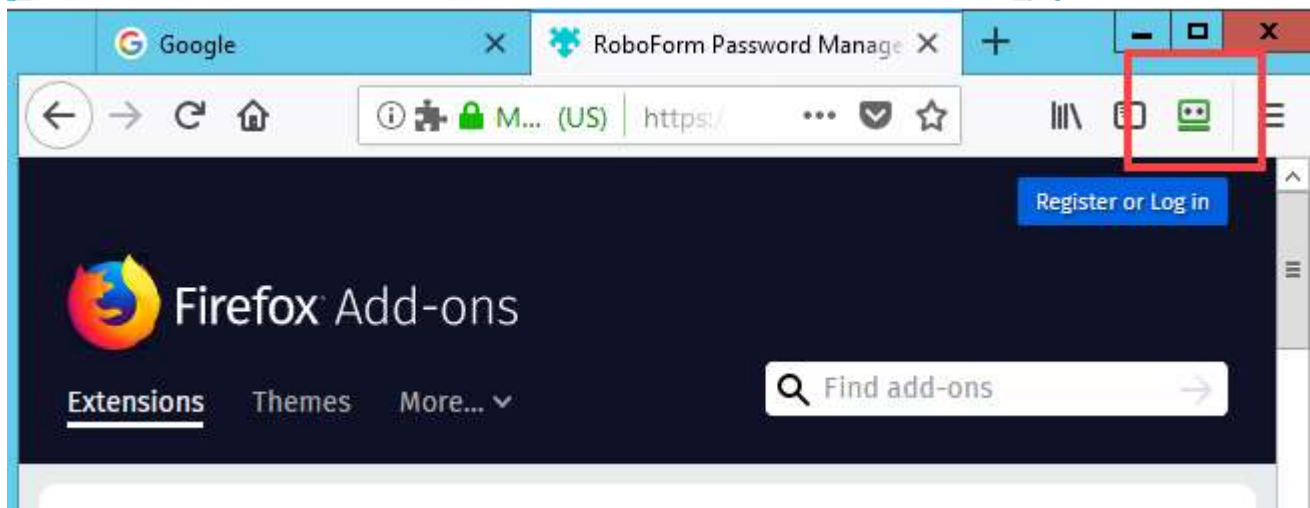
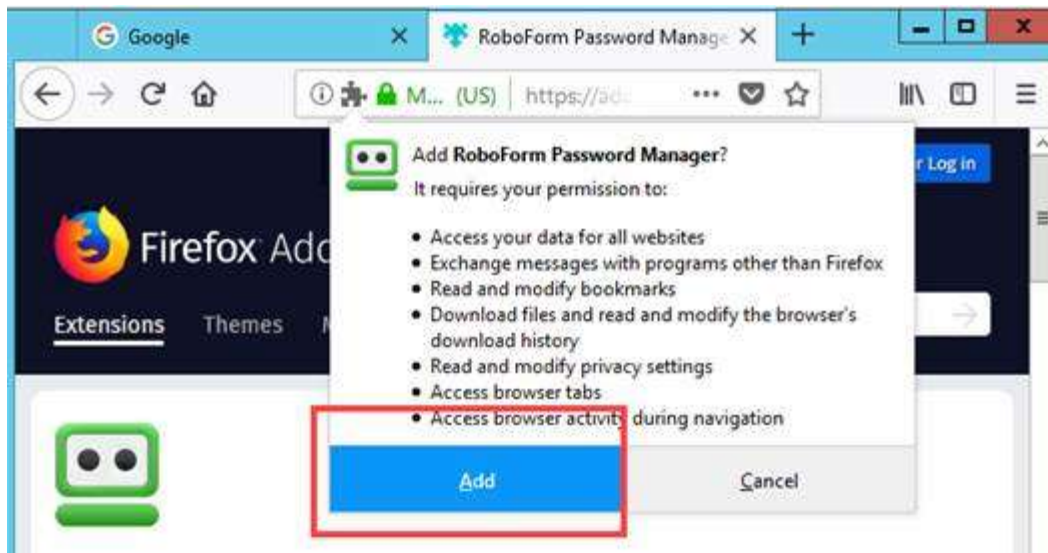
In the search results, click on Roboform Password Manager



Now click on Add to Firefox



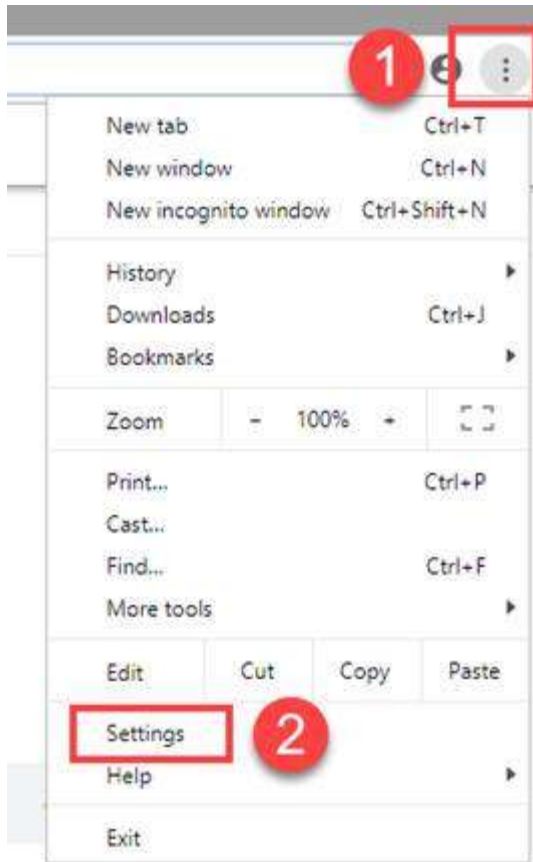
Finally, click on Add. You should then see the icon in the toolbar.



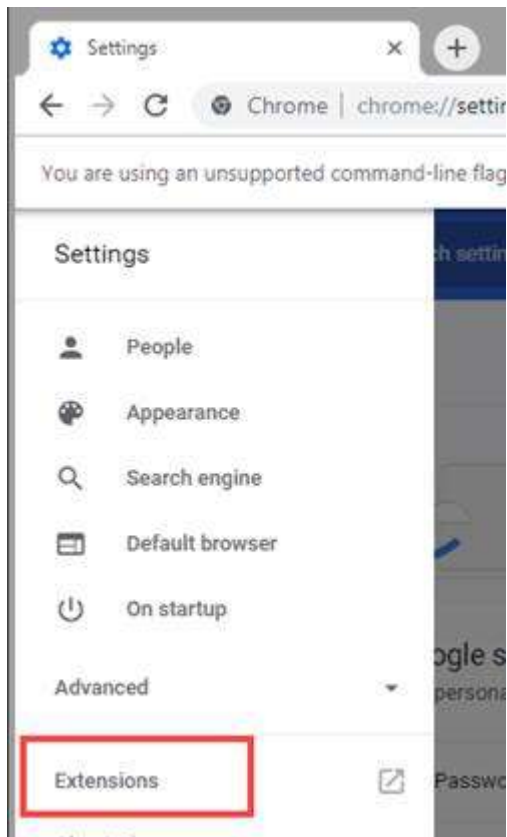
Chrome

If the Roboform icon does not appear in the Chrome toolbar, you may need to do one of the following.

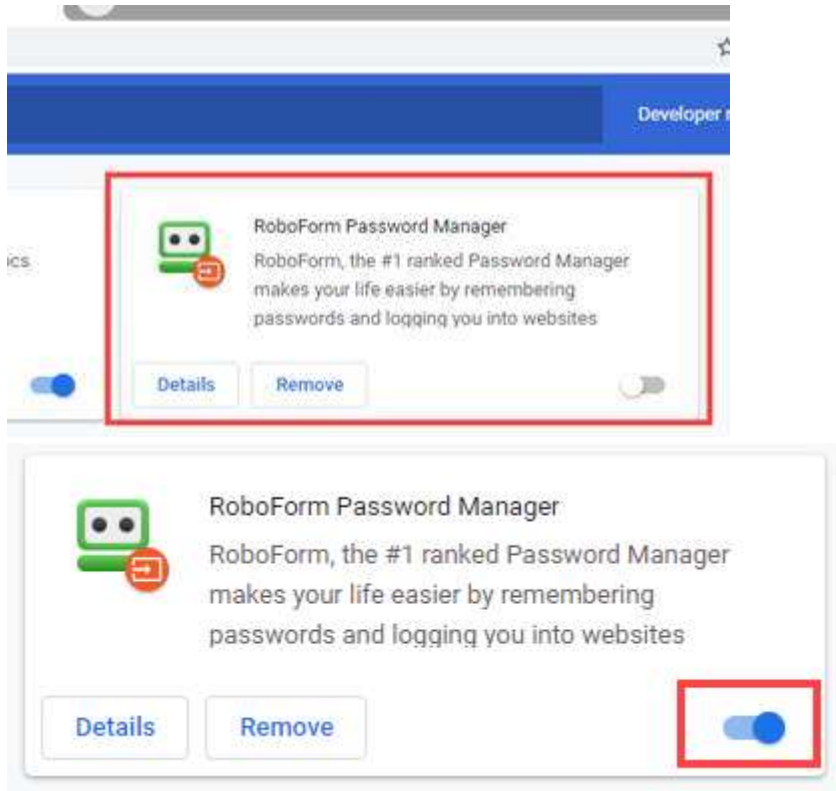
Try first –
Go to the settings button, then click on settings



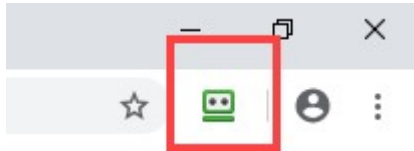
Next, click on Extensions



If you see RoboForm Password Manager on the extensions page like below, simply slide the button to "on"



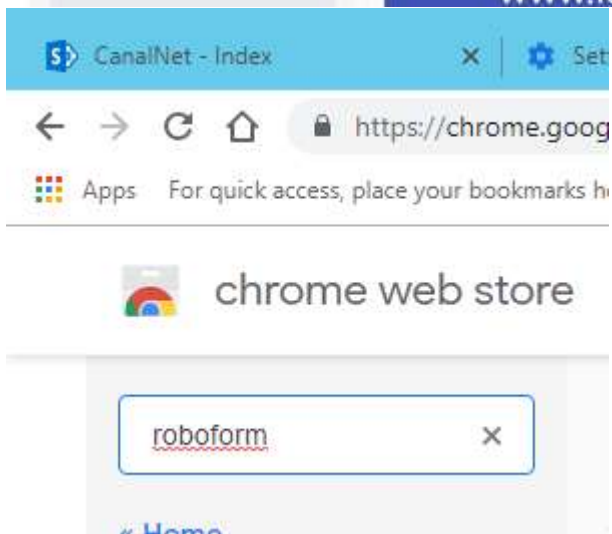
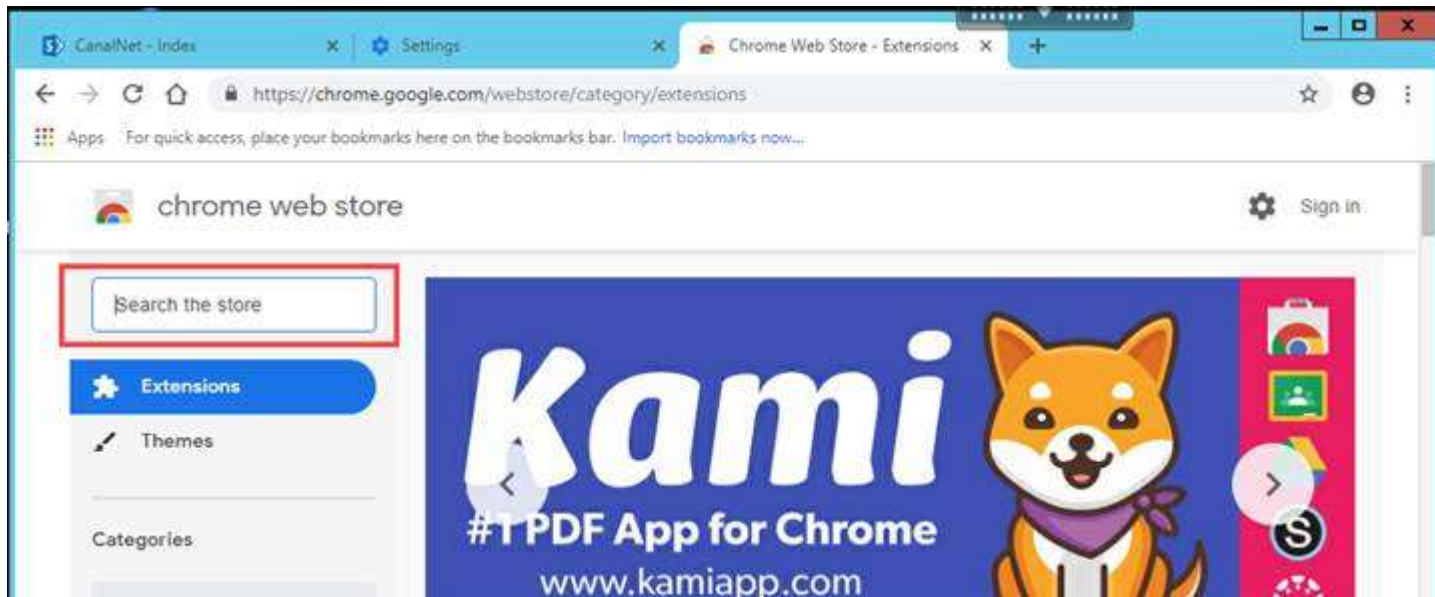
You should then see the icon in the toolbar



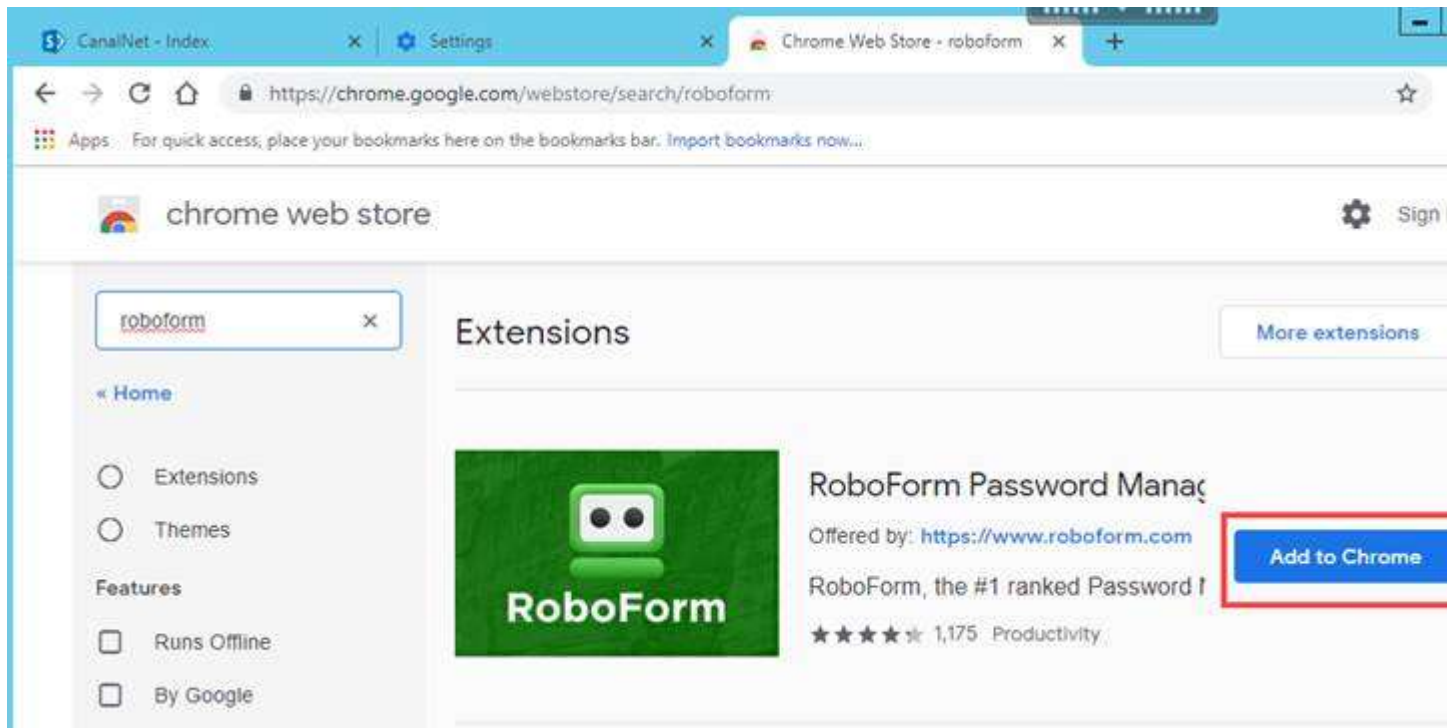
Second option (if you did not see Roboform on the extensions page)

From within Chrome, go to <https://chrome.google.com/webstore/category/extensions>

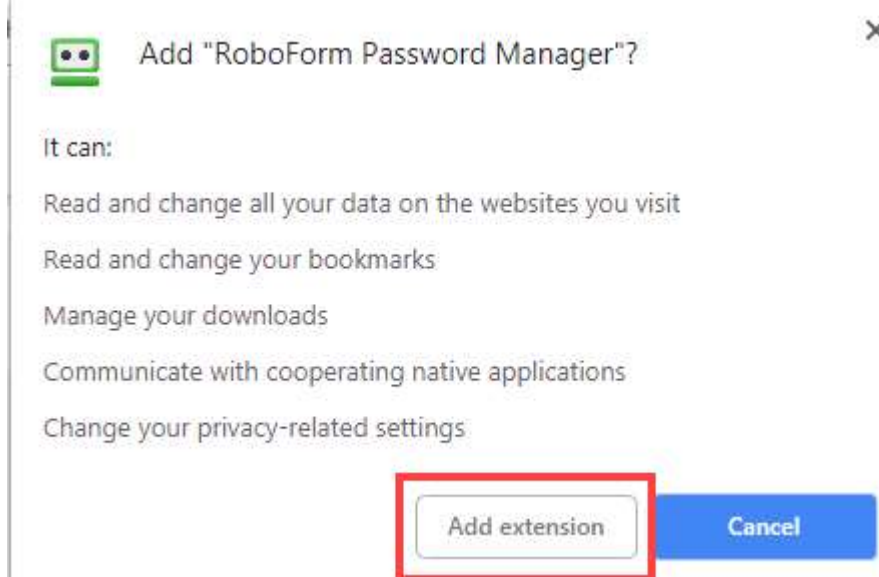
Then, in the search bar type roboform and hit enter
